



## Best for exotic seclusion Tigmi, Morocco

Only 15 miles from the mayhem of Marrakesh, secluded Tigmi, on the brow of a hill by a Berber hamlet, is a blissed-out haven that mixes style with substance and features a new spa and hammam, both of which use chemical-free ingredients sourced nearby. Overlooked by the snow-capped Atlas Mountains, with a view of an ancient kasbah, it is a place to forget the outside world. The house was built in 1840; following a sensitive 2006 restoration by local artisans, using original materials and building methods, it reopened as a hotel of 22 large rooms. It heats water from its own well using solar panels, and staff are recruited locally. Food comes in banquet-like proportions.
